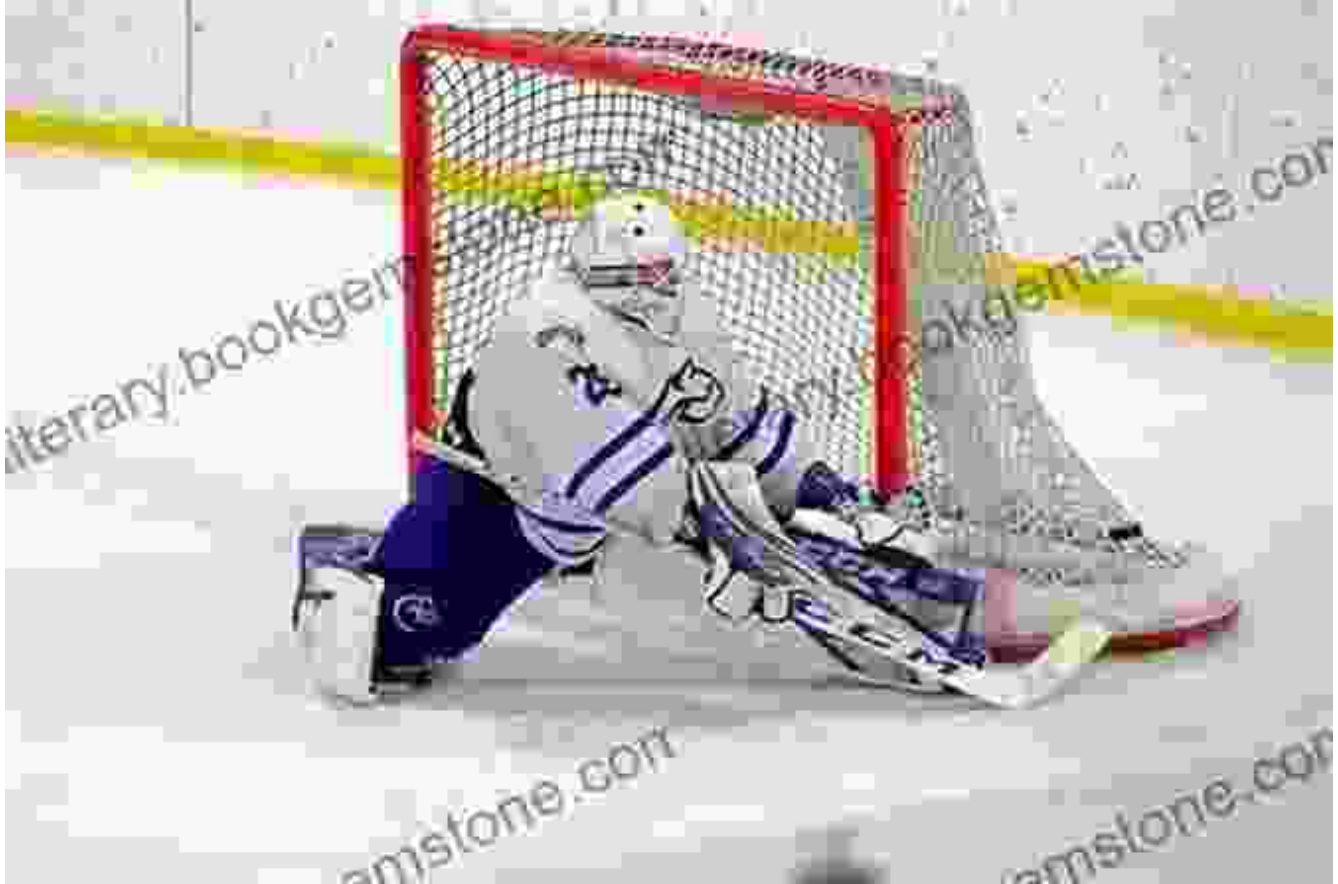
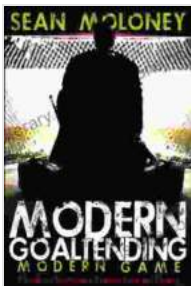


Modern Goaltending in the Modern Game: An Interview with Sean Moloney

The Evolution of Goaltending

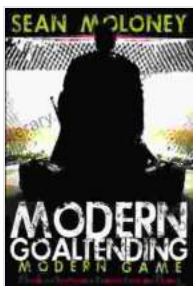

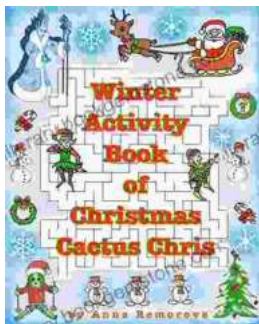
