On test day, there are a few strategies that you can use to improve your score. These strategies include:

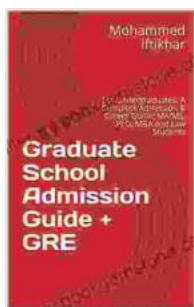
- * Start with the easiest questions. This will help you build confidence and get into a rhythm.

Scoring

The GRE is scored on a scale of 130 to 170 points. The average score is 150 points.

Your GRE score will be reported to the graduate schools that you apply to. The admissions committee will use your score to evaluate your academic readiness for their program.

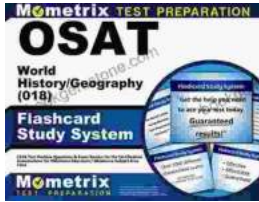
